

Walk for Myton 12 mile route



Start: The Myton Hospices, Myton Lane, Myton Road, Warwick, CV34 6PX.

- 1. Leave the Hospice grounds and head towards Myton Road, turn left at the junction of Myton Lane and on to Myton Road. Cross the road (please take care) so you are on the same side as Brittain Lane. Keep following this path until the cycle path and Myton Road diverge, then follow the cycle path until you reach the footbridge over the canal. Cross the bridge, turn left, left and left again, so that you end up on the Tow Path below (canal will be on your right-hand side).
- 2. Keep walking until you reach the railway bridge, **bridge no. 33A**. Go under this bridge and then on your left you will see a walk way 'The OffChurch Greenway (Cycle Route 41) Follow path to where it forks. Take left hand fork (thin passage) and follow path, turning left again at the metal gate and across the field to the road. PLEASE BE CAREFUL AS THIS IS A BUSY ROAD. Take care and cross the road to junction and walk straight down Village Street using pavement when possible towards Offchurch, until you reach School Hill. Turn right down School Hill.

Official refreshment stop at Offchurch village hall.

3. On leaving the refreshment stop, turn right and continue down School Hill until junction with Welsh Road. Turn left here and after approximately 10 yards just after the house) you will see a stile on your left.

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- 4. Climb over stile and follow path that runs through the middle of the field, you will reach another stile, climb over this and continue.
- 5. Follow this path and you will reach a small road that is signposted to Leamington. Walk down this road and you will reach a new gateway. Turn left and follow path that skirts the edge of the field. You will reach a gate and stile, climb latter and follow path around.
- 6. Cross Bridge. With the River Leam on your right walk diagonally across field (towards large oak tree). In the hedge on your left is a stile, climb over this and follow path until you reach the 'hole' in the hedge which you can cross through into Newbold Comyn. Take care crossing the small bridge turn right and follow the path as you leave the field and follow the path.
- 7. Turn right (keeping the old golf course on your left) follow the path straight on up to the top of the old golf course and down to the bottom of the hill going through a gate the turn left where a marshal is and another gate directing you past Newbold Comyn Arms towards Newbold Comyn Leisure Centre. Cross over to the same side as the leisure centre and turn right towards Leamington and follow cycle path.
- 8. Follow cycle path until it ends, turn left cross the road at the traffic lights turn left on Willes Road and enter Jephson Gardens on your right. Follow central path through Jephson Gardens. There is a refreshment stop available at Jephson Gardens. This is located in the Studio by the Glasshouse next to the gates of Jephson Gardens on the Parade. This is the official refreshment and comfort stop. Look for the Myton Banner. On leaving the refreshment stop please follow the path out of Jephson Gardens and onto the parade, turn right towards the traffic lights.
- 9. Cross road at traffic lights and enter the Pump Room Gardens, follow path skirting River Leam until you reach a small bridge on your left. Cross bridge and turn right up the flight of steps. Follow path that runs along River Leamington, under bridge into Victoria Park and proceed through park until you reach Princes Drive.
- 10. Cross Princes Drive at the traffic lights and follow Riverside Walk (entrance is just to your right, beside site of council tip and Severn Trent is signposted) Follow this path until the end and you reach the canal.
- 11. Turn right at the canal and follow canal until you come to the bridge that crosses the river (signposted Riverside Walk) Proceed down the steps on the right to the River Leam, turn right at the bottom of the steps and go under the bridge, follow this path with the river on your left.
- 12. Continue straight along this path, contiuning straight through St Nicholas Park with the river on your left, until you reach the steps by the Boat Club.
- 13. Proceed up the steps that take you out onto Banbury road, at the top of the steps turn left, cross over the river bridge and turn left onto Myton Road. Continue along Myton Road until you reach Myton Lane, turn left and proceed back to the Hospice.
