The difference your support and sponsorship makes Scott's story

In November 2023, Scott Pace was diagnosed with bowel cancer and was told it had spread to his liver and he had small legions on both of his lungs. With chemotherapy and radiotherapy unavailable due to the toxins in his body from his liver, Scott, aged just 30, and his family were told no further treatment was available.

Sheena Odell-Pace, Scott's mum, said:

"Being told there was nothing else they could do for Scott, we were unsure how long he would be with us. The main goal was to keep him as pain free and comfortable as possible for as long as we had with him. Myton was mentioned, and initially Scott didn't want to be admitted as he thought a hospice was where old people go to die. After a conversation with the consultants and the pain management nurse, his brother Alex and a friend took him from the hospital to the entrance of Coventry Myton Hospice in a wheelchair and looked at the virtual tour of Myton on the website. Whilst they were outside the hospice, Scott said he would be happy to go there for the Christmas period."

Scott was admitted to our Coventry Myton Hospice on 23rd December for palliative care, just two days before Christmas Day. But the family were determined



to enjoy their Christmas together.

Sheena added:

"On Christmas Eve, myself and Alex collected all our Christmas table decorations from home whilst Scott's dad, Bill, and the wonderful staff moved a few

tables and chairs into Scott's room for us to decorate. On Christmas Day, we cooked our Christmas meal of a roast duck and potatoes to take to Scott at the hospice with Myton providing vegetables to add to our feast. We enjoyed some port – a Christmas tradition of ours – and we had our family Christmas, the four of us together making the most of what was likely to be our last Christmas Day together.

"We will be forever grateful to Myton as a whole and the individual staff members that gave up their own Christmas Day to enable us to celebrate with each other, with Scott being as comfortable and pain free as possible. The day will be one we'll always remember."

A few days after Christmas, Scott's family stayed in our relatives accommodation.

Sheena said:

"We were given a key to one of the relatives accommodation suites to ensure we all got some rest, even if it was during the day if we were with Scott the night before, yet not be too far away. This closeness was a blessing and to have a place where we could go to get some rest and be back with Scott in just a few moments if anything was to happen was more reassuring than I can explain."

Scott died on Sunday 7th January 2024 aged just 30 years old, only two months after he was diagnosed.

You may have seen our Urgent Appeal to raise £240,000, which could fund the recruitment, training & salary for five registered nurses for a year, to reduce our waiting list and ensure more people in Coventry and Warwickshire can access a Hospice Bed. With the amazing support of people like you we hope we can achieve this!

Santa Suit and T-Shirt Collection



If you have chosen to have a Santa Suit or Myton T-Shirt, you will be able to pick these up from our Warwick Myton Hospice on the following days:

Location
